



ANNE WALKER CAMPAU

EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT AND GENERAL COUNSEL

In 1984, Anne launched her career at Dykema. As a young lawyer, she worked closely with fellow attorneys specializing in corporate law with an emphasis on mergers and acquisitions.

In 1990, Anne left Dykema to join her family's convenience store distribution business as EVP/General Counsel. Anne's background in mergers and acquisitions fueled fifteen acquisitions and grew J.F. Walker Company to be the eighth largest convenience store distributor in the United States with \$350 million in annual sales and over 500 employees. In late 1993, Anne was instrumental in the negotiation and sale of J.F. Walker Company to Spartan Foods.

After the sale of J.F. Walker Company, Anne and her family focused on growing another family owned business, Silver Foam Distributing Company, a Miller-Coors beer distributor headquartered in Jackson, Michigan. Anne and her sister Mary Jo, together with their father, grew Silver Foam from 400,000 cases of beer annually in 1990 to two million cases of beer annually, across Michigan, in 1999.

Anne and her husband, John Campau, purchased Comtronics from the Campau family on January 8, 1999. They immediately acquired a Nextel franchise, and then added a Verizon Wireless franchise in 2008. Today, Comtronics installs, monitors and services electronic security systems for residential and commercial applications; and for financial institutions. Anne and John have over 7,500 customers in 21 states, and they are building strategic partnerships around the country with plans to expand nationwide by 2020.

In 2010, Anne's father named her president of Silver Foam Distributing. She coordinated the sale of Silver Foam's local beer distributorship to Great Lakes Wine and Spirits in 2012, but retained its redistribution business, which currently operates a Foreign Trade Zone and exports over 10 million cases of beer to Canada and Mexico annually.

On March 1, 2014, Anne and John, together with Dean Leja, purchased Cellular and More, a 7 store Verizon Wireless franchise operation in Michigan. Anne and John combined their 4 stores and 15 years of cellular industry experience with Cellular and More. Today, the company produces over \$40 million in annual sales, with over 140 employees and 20 Verizon Wireless Premium Retail Stores in Michigan, with expansion plans to reach 30 stores by 2020.
