In 1986, John joined his family business, [Comtronics](#), and became president in 1994. He and his wife, Anne Campau, purchased the security company from John's family on January 8, 1999, and John has remained president of the company the past 25 years. They immediately acquired a Nextel franchise, and then added a Verizon Wireless franchise in 2008. Today, Comtronics installs, monitors and services electronic security systems for residential and commercial applications; and for financial institutions. John and Anne have over 10,000 customers in 26 states, and they recently purchased Ranch & Coast Security in Southern California

In 1989, John was elected to the board of the John George Home, a 65 year-old non-profit home for poor, elderly, disadvantaged gentlemen; and he served on the board for 20 years, four years as president. In 2001, the Jackson Chamber of Commerce named John, Small Business Person of the Year; and in 2004 he appeared on the March cover of Jackson Magazine, [John Campau: Embracing Technology at Comtronics](#). Two years later, the Jackson Citizen Patriot named John, [2006 Citizen of the Year](#). He made front page news in the 150 year-old newspaper for his many years of charity work in the community; and for his efforts leading a campaign to save the John George Home from closing.

John is a 33-year expert in the electronic security industry, and he has participated in dozens of interviews and multiple speaking engagements at industry events around the country. He currently serves on the Honeywell National Dealer Advisory Board and he was named Dealer of the Year by Honeywell in 2012. John was the grand prize winner of a 2015 Ford Mustang GT Convertible in a Honeywell national sales contest. He was featured on the January cover of Security Sales & Integration Magazine, [2014 Industry Forecast Issue](#); December 2016 Cover of Security Systems News, Comtronics Moves Monitoring to NMC; January cover of SDM Magazine, [2017 Industry Forecast Issue](#); and the January Cover of Security Sales & Integration Magazine, 2018 Industry Forecast Issue. John loves to travel, and has visited over 35 countries around the world.

On March 1, 2014, John and Anne, together with Dean Leja, purchased [Cellular and More](#), a 7 store Verizon Wireless franchise operation in Michigan. John and Anne combined their 15 years of cellular industry experience with Cellular and More. Today, the company produces over \$45 million in annual sales, with 140 employees and 23 Verizon Wireless Premium Retail Stores in Michigan.
